ORDINANCE NO. 1634

A BILL FOR: An Ordinance vacating Ferry Street from the South line of the presently located Pacific Highway 99E to the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks in the City of Albany, Oregon.

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 1624 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor July 31, 1945, it was provided for the time and manner of vacating Ferry Street from the South line of the presently located Pacific Highway 99E to the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks in the City of Albany, Oregon;

AND WHEPEAS, pursuant to said Ordinance, the Recorder gave notice of the vacation of said portion of said street for the time and in the manner provided by law and said Ordinance and in said notice it was provided that September 12, 1945, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. of said day be the time set for the hearing of objections to the vacation of said portion of said street and this being the time and date set for said hearing and no objections and remonstrances being made or filed to said vacation or any portion thereof.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ferry Street from the South line of the presently located Pacific Highway 99E to the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks in the City of Albany, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.
