A BILL FOR: An Ordinance to appropriate \$1004.00 of the general funds of the City of Albany for the purchase of one International Gas Tractor with Mower Equipment from Howard Cooper Corporation and to authorize payment of same.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of One Thousand and Four (\$1004.00) Dollars, it being the price heretofore agreed upon with Howard Cooper Corporation for the purchase of One International Gas Tractor with Mower Equipment and as shown by the invoice therefor now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to Howard Cooper Corporation the general fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth.

It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
