ORDINANCE NO. 1673

A Bill For:

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of vacating Eighth Street from Paple to Vine Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

THE FEOFLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLIOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon are hereby authorized and directed to proced to vacate Eighth Street from Mable to Vine Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the vacation of said street by publishing the same in the Greater Gregon, a newspaper of general circulation published in the Gity of a City of Albany, Gregon, once each week for four successive weeks, which said notice shall describe the street herein contemplated to be vacated and said notice shall state that the Council will, on the 22nd day of May, 1946, at 9:30 o'clock PM of said day, hear objections or remonstrances to the vacation of said street by any person or persons interested therein and particularly by the owners of the real property affected thereby. The Recorder, within five days after the first publication of said notice, shall post or cause to be posted at or near each end of said street herein proposed to be vacated, a copy of said notice. The posting and first publication or sugh notice shall not be less than twenty-eight days before the time of such hearing.
