AN ORDINANCE to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 41 adopted by said Council on the 23 rd day of Nay, 1945 to make on Yadison Street from the South line fo First St. to the North ilne of Ninth Street; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said city to enter a statement of such assessment in the Dooket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS on the 25 th day of April, 1945 the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Vadison Street from the south IIne of First Street to the North line of Ninth Street in the following manner to-wit:

1. By grading said streets to the proper sub-grade.
2. By surfacing the radway of said street full width with full intersections with crushed rock and crushed gravel base and oil mat surface.
3. By laying and constructing conorete gutters.
4. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary.
5. By installing a proper drainage system on said streets.
and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. $28, "$ and adopted the 25 th day of April, 1945.

THEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 28 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Street in the manner specified in said resolution No. 28 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 19th day of lay, 1945.

WHEREAS the Council on the 19 th day of May, 1945 , by Resolution No. 41 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council, proposed to improve Vadison St. from the South line of First to the North line of Ninth Street in the Manner provided in said Resolution No 41 and;

WHEREAS in and by said Resolution No. 41 edopted as aforesaid by the Counoil the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of said City and;

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and;

WHEREAS the said Council in and by said Fesolution No 41 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said street to be pald by the owmers of the real property adfacent to said portion of said Street to be improved as specified in said Fesolution No. 41 to be the sum of $\$ 13780.20$.

Section 1. That Madison Street in the City of Albany, Oregon fram the South
1ine of First Street to the North line of Ninth Street be improved as follows:

1. By grading sald streets to the proper sub-grade.
2. By surfacing the roadway of said street full with with intersections with crushed rock and crushed gravel.
3. By laying and constructing concrete gutters.
4. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary.
5. By instaliing a proper drainage system on said streets.
and in accordance with said Resolution No. 41 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Orezon, on the 19 th day of hay, 1945.

Saotion 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street
in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by
Resolution No, 41 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said
portion of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of $\$ 13730.20$.
Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said
