A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE authorizing a loan for a term of years, providing for the manner of issuing bonds therefor, and the time and manner of paying the same, and authorizing the sale thereof, for the purpose of providing funds for the construction of main sewers in the City of Albany, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, have deemed it expedient and necessary to construct main sewers in said city as follows;

Beginning at the manhole on the Geary St. trunk sewer at the intersection of Geary and Willamette Sts. in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence easterly on Willamette St. to Columbus St., thence Southerly akong Columbus Street to a point near the south line of the new Pacific Highway, a total distance of 3800 feet, and with branch main sewer lines extending from a paint on said Highway and running thence easterly along said Highway a distance of 680 feet; also a branch of said main line beginning at the point where the same terminates at the new Pacific Highway and running thence westerly along said Highway a distance of 670 feet; also beginning at the point where said main sewer terminates at the new Pacific Highway and running easterly along said Highway a distance of 1270 feet,

and also

From the north line of the Southern Pacific Railroad on 6th and Hill Sts. and running southerly on Hill St. 2390 feet, thence easterly 655 ft. to Sherman and Hackleman Sts., thence southerly diagonally across Sherman St. 170 feet. Also, a branch main beginning at the intersection of Hill and Hackleman Sts. and running westerly along Hackleman St. 1185 feet to the east line of Block 6 in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition to Albany, Oregon.

Also, beginning at the manhole at the junction of the Montgomery St. and the 12th St. sewers and running southerly 1200 feet, also beginning at its intersection with the center line of Block 2 in Bacon's Addition to the City of Albany, and running theory easterly 900 feet to the center line of Block 4 in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition.

Also, from the intersection of Fifth and Geary Sts., easterly to the southeast corner of Lot 9 in Block 1, Bryant's Addition and main beginning near the north-west corner of Lot 6 in St. James Park Addition and running easterly to a point north of the center line of Lot 4, St. James Park Addition.

That said sewers are to be constructed according to the plans and specifications therefor, now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council pursuant to Ordinance No. 1657 of said City duly adopted November 14, 1945, have entered into a contract with Leonard & Slate, Oregon Ltd., for the construction of that portion of said sewers herein first above described at and for the agreed contract price of Twenty-six Thousand Four Hundred Forty-two and Fifty hundredths Dollars (\$26,442.50,) and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of said city, under and pursuant to Ordinance No. 1708 adopted May 22, 1946 have entered into a contract with R. L. Colbert for the construction of the remaining sewers hereinabove described at and for the agreed contract price of Twenty-nine Thousand Forty-nine and Thirty hundredths Dollars (\$29,049.30), and

WHEREAS, the entire cost of the construction of said sewers hereinabove described as per the two contracts hereinabove referred to, is the aggregate sum of Fifty-five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-one and Eighty hundredths Dollars (\$55,491.80),

WHEREAS, it is necessary, expedient, and desirable to issue the general obligation bonds of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of financing the cost of constructing the above mentioned main sewers in accordance with the ordinances aforesaid and the plans and specifications therefor,

THEREFORE. THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLO'S:

Section 1. That in order to finance the cost of the construction of main sewers in the City of Albany, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at the manhole on the Geary Street trunk sewer at the intersection of Geary and Willamette Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence easterly on Willamette Street to Columbus Street, thence southerly along Columbus Street to a point near the south line of the new Pacific Highway, a total distance of 3800 feet, and with branch main sewer lines extending from a point of said main sewer where the same intersects the old Pacific Highway and extending westerly therefrom along said old Pacific Highway a distance of 560 feet; also beginning at said point on said Highway and running thence easterly along said Highway a distance of 6.0 feet; also a branch of said main line beginning at the point where the same terminates at the new Pacific highway where the same terminates at the new Facific Highway and running thence westerly along said Highway a distance of 670 feet; also beginning at the point where said main sewer terminates at the new Facific Highway and running easterly along said Highway a distance of 1270 feet.

From the north line of the Southern Pacific Railroad on 6th and Hill Sts. and running southerly on Hill St. 2390 feet, thence easterly 655 feet to Sherman and hackleman Sts., thence southerly diagonally across Sherman St. 170 feet. Also, a branch main beginning at the intersection of Hill and Hackleman Sts. and running westerly along Hackleman St. 1185 feet to the east line of Block 6 in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition to Albany, Oregoni

Also, beginning at the menhole at the junction of the Montgomery St. and the 12th St. sewers and running southerly 1200 feet, also beginning at its intersection with the center line of Block 2 in Bacon's Addition to the City of Albany, and running thence easterly 900 feet to the center line of Block 4 in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition.

Also, from the intersection of Fifth and Geary Sts., easterly to the southeast corner of Lot 9 in Block 1, Bryant's Addition and main beginning near the north west corner of Lot 6 in St. James Park Addition and running easterly to a point north of the center line of Lot 4, St. James Park Addition.

There shall be issued the general obligation negotable interest bearing bonds of the City of Albany, Oregon, in the sum of Fifty-five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-one and Eighty hundredths Dollars (\$55,491.80). That said bonds shall be issued in denominations of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000), except one of such bonds shall be in the denomination of Four Hundred Ninety-one and Eighty hundredths Dollars (\$491.80), and said bonds shall be numbered one (1) to fifty-six (56) inclusive. Said bond to be issued in the sum of Four Hundred Ninety-one and Eighty hundredths Dollars (\$491.80) to be numbered fifty-six (56); provided, however, that the City of Albany, Oregon, may after five (5) years from the date hereof or at any interest paying date thereafter, redeem these bonds upon notice of intention so to do being published once each week for four (4) successive weeks in a newspaper published in the city of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, that upon said date not less than three months from the date of the first publication of said notice, said City intends to redeem and pay said bond or bonds, stating the number thereof.

That said bonds shall be payable to the bearer and shall mature serially in accordance with the following schedule of maturities, towit:

Section 2. Each of said bonds shall be signed by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, and attested by the Recorder of said city, and before the delivery therof, shall be registered by the City Treasurer. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed five per cent (5%) per annum, interest payable semi-annually on the second day of January and the second day of July of each year subsequent to the date of said bonds, principal and interest to be payable in lewful money of the United States of America at the office of the Treasurer of the City of Albany, Oregon. Said bond issue shall be known as the "1946 Sewer Bonds".

Section 3. That the bonds herein authorized shall be su stantially in the following form, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, for value received hereby promises and agrees to pay to the bearer the sum of

in lawful money of the United States of America on the presentation and surrender of this bond on the second day of July, 19 , with interest thereon at the rate of per annum, payable semi-annually in like lawful money on the second day of January and the second day of July of each year upon presentation of the proper coupons hereunto annexed, principal and interest payable at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Albany, Oregon.

This bond is one of a series of like date and tenor, except as to maturity, and issued as a part of the total issue of Fifty-five /Thousand Four Bundred Ninety-one and Eighty Bundredths Dollars (\$55,491.80) of such bonds for the purpose of financing the cost of the construction of main sewers of said city of Albany, Oregon and is issued under and pursuant to the provisions of the charter of said city and the authority of Section 95-1603 O.C.L.A., as amended, and is a general obligation of the city of Albany, Oregon, aforesaid, and it is further certified and recited that all acts, conditions, and things required to exist or be done by the Mayor and Council of said city of Albany, Oregon, precedent to and in the issuance and sale of this bond, have happended and have been duly and regularly performed as required by law and that this bond, together with all indebtedness of said city of Albany, does not exceed any constitutional, statutory or charter limitation. But provided, however, that the City of Albany, Oregon, may after (5) years from the date hereof or at any interest paying date thereafter, redeem this bond upon notice of intention so to do being published once each week for four (4) successive weeks in a newspaper published in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, that upon said date not less than three months from the date of the first publication of said notice, said City intends to redeem and pay said bond or bonds, stating the number thereof.

For the fulfillment of the conditions of this obligation the full faith and credit of the City of Albany, Oregon, are here y irrevocably pledged.

Section 4. That the full faith and credit of said City of Albany, Oregon, are hereby pledged to the holder of each of said bonds for the punctual payment of the principal and interest thereof when and as the same shall become due and said City of Albany, Oregon, hereby covenants and agrees with each successive holder of said bonds that there shall be ascertained and levied annually a tax against all taxable property within said City sufficient to pay the interest accrued on said bonds as it becomes due; and in addition thereto, said City sahll cause to be levied a tax against all taxable property within said City in an amount sufficient to meet the payment in full of the principal of said bonds and each of them as and when they serially become due and that said taxes shall be collected at the time and in the manner as prescribed by law for all other City purposes within said City.

Section 5. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and he is hereby instructed to advertise the aforesaid bonds for sale notifying all persons desiring to bid for said bonds, that sealed bids will be received by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, at the Recorder's office of said City until seven o'clock P. That said notice shall provide that all bids for such bonds shall be in writing and accompanied by a certified check on a bank doing business in the State of Oregon, for not less than two per cent (2%) of the par value of the bonds offered for sale, and that the Council may reject any or all of said bids. That said notice of the sale of said bonds shall be substantially in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

All bids for such bonds shall be in writing and shall be accompanied by a certified check on a bank doing business in the State of Oregon, for not less than Two per cent (2%) of the par value of the bonds hereby offered for sale; said bonds shall be sold to the highest responsible bidder for not less than Ninety-eight per cent (98%) of their par value and the entire amount of accrued interest; the interest on said bonds shall be not more than Five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually at the office of the Treasurer of the City of Albany, Oregon.

The Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
