

ORDINANCE No. 1739

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$483.26 out of the General Funds of the City of Albany to be used in payment for one 1946 Ford 4 Door Sedan, and authorizing payment of the same to the Nissen Motor Co.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon and charged to the general funds, the sum of \$483.26, it being the price heretofore agreed upon, with the Nissen Motor Co. for one 1946 Ford 4 Door Sedan, said amount being the difference to be paid in addition to one 1942 Four Door Plymouth Sedan at a value of \$800.00, as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to the Nissen Motor Co. the general fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth. That the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the General Fund of said City.
