A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE vacating a certain unnamed street lying directly South of Pipe's South Albany Addition and directly North of John Millard Land Plat (lot 6) and connecting B Street with Pacific Highway in the City of Albany, Oregon; said street being 40 feet in width am approximately 110 feet in length.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1766 passed by the Council and approved by the Hayor of the City of Albany on the 27th day of February, 1947, it was provided a time and manner of vacating a certain unnamed street lying directly South of Fipe's South Albany Addition and directly North of John Millard Land Plat (lot 6) in Albany, Linn County, Oregon.
