A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with D. F. EcKenzie and O. L. Bowman for the improvement of Denver Street from the north line of Eighth Street to the south line of the Santiam Road in the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOTS:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1791, of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in said City be improved, to-wit: Denver Street from the north line of Eighth Street to the south line of the Santiam Road.

Said improvement to be made in the following manner:

- By paving the same with suitable hard surface pavement.
- 2.
- By grading the same to the proper sub-grade. By installing concrete curbs, sidewalks and gutters 3.
- wherever necessary. By making all other installations necessary to completely improve said street. 4.

and in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates of Walter W. Larsen, Engineer, then on file in the office of the Recorder of said City; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of said City of Albany, give notice for bids for the making of said im-provement in the manner provided by law and said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder according to law and the Ordinance last afore-said, to-wit: on the 16th day of May, 1947, D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman presented to the Council of the City of Albany, their bid for making said improvement in the manner aforesaid, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform all the labor nec-essary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Aggregate bid based on Engineer's estimates \$4168.10.

AND "THEREAS the said D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman were the lowest bidders for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid made therefor:

Section 1. That the bid of D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Fowmer for the improvement of Denver Street from the north line of Eighth Street to the south line of the Santiam Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner as specified in said Ordinance No. 1791, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in That the bid of D. F. EcKenzie and O. L. Eowman writing with the said D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman for the making of said improvement on behalf of the City of Albany upon the terms men-tioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned and in the manner and form provided by law.

Said contract shall provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the thirty-first day of October, 1947 unless further time be extended by the Council of said City, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages in the amount of \$25,00 per day for each and every day said work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman shall furnish a bond in the sum of \$2084.05 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, con-ditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
