ORDINANCE NO. 1819

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 1502 entitled "An ordinance regulating and licensing the business of canvassing or peddling of goods, wares, and merchandise by transient or itinerant peddlers: Defining what shall constitute a transient or itinerant peddler; and providing a penalty for the violation thereof."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 3 be amended by adding after the word "in" the following: , or from the streets or sidewalks.

That Section 6 (a) Class A. (1) be amended as follows:

Per	day	\$ 10.00
Per	week	\$ 30.00
Per	month	\$ 90.00
Per	quarter	\$250.00
Per	year	\$500.00

That the remainder of the ordinance shall remain as written except for the amendments here made.
