

## ORDINANCE NO. 1873

## A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE declaring a deficit on account of the improvement of TWELFTH STREET from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; THIRTEENTH STREET from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; FOURTEENTH STREET from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; WALNUT STREET from the south line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Fifteenth Street; MAPLE STREET from the south line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Fifteenth Street; in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, by D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman, and directing the Recorder of said City to place to the debit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed and entered of record in the Docket of City Liens of the City of Albany, Oregon for the making of said improvement, their proportionate share of such deficit.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a deficit of \$968.44 is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract heretofore entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and D. F. McKenzie and O. L. Bowman for the improvement of Twelfth Street from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; Thirteenth Street from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; Fourteenth Street from the east line of Elm Street to the west line of Vine Street; Walnut Street from the south line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Fifteenth Street; Maple Street from the south line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Fifteenth Street; in the City of Albany, Oregon, against the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed for the making of said improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of City Liens of said City, in the deficit column thereof, the sum of \$968.44 based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed for making such improvement and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said Streets, said deficit against the various owners, or reputed owners, of the various parcels of real estate, and in the sums as follows, to-wit:
