ORDININGS # 1959

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 1496, which is entitled "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PUNISHING OFFENSES AGAINST THE PUBLIC PEACE, SAFETY, MORALS, AND GENERAL WELFARE" passed January 10, 1940, by amending Section 84 thereof, and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. That Section 84 be amended to read as follows:

Section 84. PENALTIES. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than 31 nor more than 3250, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a term of not less than 1 day nor more than 50 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
