## ORDINANCE NO. $2 / 20$

AN ORDIMANCE to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the council of the C1ty of Albany had determined to maisc in Resolution No. 85 adopted by said council on the 13 th day of April, 1949 for Burkhart from the north 11ne of 998 to the south line of the existing pavement of the old Salem Road in the City of Albany, oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said atreet that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of sald street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of sald City.

WHERFAS on the 13th day of April, 1949 the Council of the City of Albany, oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to maise plans and specifications for the improvement of Burkhart from the north line of 99 E to the south inne of the existing pavement of the Old Salem Romd, in the following manner, towit:

1. By preparing the proper sub-grade.
2. By installing hard surface material.
and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said city, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. $66{ }^{\mathrm{m}}$ and adopted the 13th day of April, 1949.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Reolution No. 66 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said street in the manner specifled in said Resolution No, 66 and riled said plans specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on 23 th day of Apr1l, 19 '9.

WHEREAS the Council on the 13 th day of April, 1949 by Resolution No. 85 duly adopted by sald council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve Burkhart Street from the north inne of 99E to the south line of the existing pavement of the Old Salem Road in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 85, and

> WHERRAS, in and by said Resolution No. 85 adopted as afore sald by the council the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by sald council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said city, and

WHEREAS the Recorder in pursuance of sald order and direction of the council or said city did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said eity, and

WHEREAS, the sald council in and by said Resolution No. 85 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making sald improvement of sald street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald portion of said street to be improved as specified in sald Reolustion No. 85 to be the sum of $\$ 7,629.60$.

## IHEREFORE

THE PEOPLB OF THE CITY OF Cibany DO CRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
section 1. That Burkhart Street from the north 11ne of 99E to the south line of the existing pavement of the 01d Salem Road in the city of Albany, Oragon be improved as follows:

1. By preparing the proper sub-grade.
2. By installing herd surface material.
all In accordance with said Resolution No. 85 and the plans and spedifications for said improvement filed by the city Engineer With the Recomer of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 13th day of April, 1949.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said \#treet in the manner heretofore determined by the council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 85 to be pald by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to be the sum of $35,756.80$

Section 3. That the proportionste share of said probable cost of cald improvement of said street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to sald part of safd street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said council in and by said Resolution No. 85 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum sot and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
