ORDINANCE NO. 2149

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE SALARY OF \$75.00 PER MONTH TO THE CITY HEALTH OFFICER THROUGH DECEMBER 1949, AND DECLAREG AN EXERGENCY.

Whereas the budget for 1949-50 as approved by ordinance did not provide for a salary to the City Health Officer;

Whereas the budget did provide funds for use by the Health Department;

Whereas ir. W.C. Holey had been appointed City Health Officer on or about July 1948 and his salary during that fiscal year was set \$75.00 per month,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be appropriated from the Health Department funds the sum of \$375.00 and the Recorder shall draw his warrant in this sum in favor of Dr. W. C. Roley; that the Recorder is further authorized to draw his warrant in the sum of \$75.00 at the end of December 1949 as the final salary payment to Dr. W. C. Roley in his capacity as City Health Officer.

Section 2. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefor an emergency is nerecy declared to exist and this ordinance snall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the council and approval by the Eayor.
