*Ordinance 2152*

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PUNISHING PERSONS CAUSING A CHILD TO BECOME OR TO REMAIN A DEPENDENT OR DELINQUENT CHILD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. DEFINITION. The word "person" as used in this ordinance shall include parent or parents, legal guardian or any other person having the care or custody of a child under the age of 18 years.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully do any act which causes or tends to cause any child under the age of 18 years to become a dependent or delinquent child as defined by any statute of the State of Oregon or to live or to conduct himself or herself or remain such a dependent or delinquent child.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any parent, parents or legal guardian or any other persons having the care or custody of a child under the age of 18 years to fail to properly supervise and care for such child in that such failure or supervision or care shall cause the child to become a dependent or delinquent child as defined by a statute of the State of Oregon, or to live and conduct himself or herself as to be or to remain such a dependent or delinquent child.

Section 4. PENALTIES. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court of the City of Albany be punished by fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$250.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for a term of not less than one day nor more than 50 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Section 5. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and its approval by the mayor of the City of Albany.
