ORDINANCE NO. 2162

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1422 which is AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON: PROVIDING FOR TRAFFIC RIGHS, MARKERS AND SIGNALS; PHOVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Ordinance No. 1422 be amended by amending Section 79 thereof so that a further sub-section shall be added thereto and the sub-title be amended so that Section 79 shall be enacted as follows:

Section 79. PARKING TIME LIMIT AND MOVING UNLAWFULLY PARKED VEHICLES FROM STREETS.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave a parked vehicle upon the streets of the City of Albany, Oregon continuously and for more than five consecutive days.

That the remaining provisions of said Section 79 shall be re-designated and that (a) shall be designated as (b), and (b) shall be designated as (c).

Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
