

ORDINANCE NO. 2168

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE CONTRACT WITH CORNELL, HOWLAND, HAYES AND MERRYFIELD, CONSULTING ENGINEERS OF CORVALLIS, OREGON FOR THE PREPARATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the State Law the City of Albany is required to construct a sewage treatment plant and the State Sanitary Authority has advised the City that such a plant shall be constructed so that the Willamette River will be free of sewage from the City of Albany in 1952, it is necessary therefore that plans be drawn looking forward to the construction of sewage treatment plant, and

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Albany enter into a contract with the engineering firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, Corvallis, Oregon, for the preparation of plans and specifications of a sewage treatment plant which will be located on property which belongs to the City of Albany, Oregon, under such terms as might be mutually satisfactory between the contracting parties, and authorize payment of such reasonable fee as agreed upon in the contract.

That the Mayor of the City of Albany be authorized to execute such contract and the Recorder to attest such signature to bind the City of Albany for the payment therefor.

Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
