

ORDINANCE NO. 2317

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AN ADDITIONAL EMPLOYEE IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND SETTING UP HIS SALARY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the present fire hazard and the State Law which regulates the time which any employee of the Fire Department is limited per week, and

WHEREAS, such person shall be employed at a salary of not more than \$260.00 per month and such person shall be an experienced fireman and such salary shall be charged to the Fire Department under the budget,

Now, therefore, the people of the City of Albany do ordain:

1. That an additional fireman be employed by the City of Albany for the Fire Department and that such employment be entered into immediately; that such employee shall be an experience fireman and shall receive a salary of not more than \$260.00 monthly, and the Recorder is authorized to draw his warrant not to exceed said sum monthly for his employment and to charge same to the Fire Department; that such hiring shall continue until further action of the council or until the Fire Chief shall notify the council that the emergency has passed.

2. Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
