

ORDINANCE NO. 2224

AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT ASSESSMENT AND DIRECTING THAT CORRECTING ENTRIES BE MADE AND AUTHORIZING REPAYMENT.

WHEREAS, heretofore in the year 1949 certain assessments assessments were made arising out of the improvements of Twelfth Avenue and by inadvertance there was charged to H. D. Rumbaugh who owns 60 foot frontage on said West Twelfth Avenue in Rose Addition the sum of \$ 44 89 in excess of that which should have been assessed to him.

WHEREAS, the Mennonite Church who owns property on Twelfth Avenue being 11 feet in Rose Addition and the remaining in the Mennonite Church Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, did receive the benefits of the street improvements and by inadvertance this 11 feet area which belong to said Mennonite Church had been charged to H. D. Rumbaugh and the Trustees of the Mennonite Church should be charged with said deficit of \$ 44 89

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said assessment should be corrected, crediting to H. D. Rumbaugh the sum of \$ 44 89 which the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, should draw against the Liens Principal fund and the Trustees of the Mennonite Church of Albany, Oregon, should be charged with the sum of \$ 44 89 and they shall forthwith be notified of the correction in the assessments records, which 1949 assessment failed to reflect their ownership of the 11 foot strip which had been heretofere included in the H. D. Rumbaugh tract.
