

ORDINANCE NO. 2309

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND ACTING CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE CARS FROM THE NISSEN MOTOR COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids upon two police cars for the City of Albany and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Police Committee and the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Acting City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Nissen Motor Company of Albany, Oregon, for the purchase of two 1951 Ford four-door sedans with the V-8 motors at the bid price for the two units in the sum of \$3,670.00 less trade-in allowance on two 1950 Plymouth sedans in the sum of \$2,780.00 making a balance upon the contract in the sum of \$890.00.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
