

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE REPORT OF THE VIEWERS CONCERNING THE OPENING OF PINE STREET FROM THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF EIGHTH AVENUE TO THE CENTER LINE OF NINTH AVENUE IN THE CITY OF ALBANY:

WHEREAS, the viewers as provided in Ordinance No. 2305 did file their written report containing the findings as to damages or benefits for the proposed opening of Pine Street from the southerly line of Eighth Avenue to the center line of Ninth Avenue in the City of Albany on the 5th day of September, 1951, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany deemed it necessary to ask that a more complete report be filed therein, and

WHEREAS, the said report has been filed, the remonstrance heard, and being fully apprised of the facts and circumstances involved in the proposed opening,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the supplemental viewers report made and filed in accordance with Ordinance No. 2305 in that the benefits offset the damages on the proposed opening of Pine Street from the southerly line of Eighth Avenue to the center line of Ninth Avenue, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A street 66 feet in width, being 33 feet in width on either side of the center line thereof, said center line being described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Pine Street in the City of Albany, projected southerly with the southerly line of Eighth Avenue in said City of Albany and from said point running south 90° East along the extended projection of the center line of said Pine Street southerly 237.25 feet to an iron rod in the center of Ninth Avenue in said City of Albany projected easterly,

shall be and is hereby adopted.
