

ORDINANCE NO. 2477

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PUMP WITH THE PACIFIC PUMPING COMPANY IN A SUM NOT EXCEEDING \$400.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this Ordinance, deem it impracticable to obtain bids upon a circulation pump for the swimming pool.


Section 2: The Mayor and the City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Circulation Pump, to-wit:  
1-Pacific 3"B Type L. U. Unitype Centrifugal Bronze Fitted Pump of 5 Horse Power 3 phase 1750 R. P. M. Motor not to exceed the sum of \$400.00.

By this Ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.


In as much as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
