

ORDINANCE NO. 2494

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2476, SEC. 7, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING PRIVATE DETECTIVES AND MERCHANT POLICE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES OF THE VIOLATION THEREOF."


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 2476, entitled "An Ordinance Licensing and Regulating Private Detectives and Merchant Police and Providing For Penalties of the Violation Thereof" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 7: The licensee or applicant shall, before receiving a license furnish a good and sufficient surety bond in the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) conditioned upon the faithful performance and honest conduct of himself and his employees who will be engaged in watching, guarding, or protective undertakings of the person, firm, or corporation licensed hereunder. Such bond shall be payable to the City of Albany and any other affected persons, business or corporation and shall guarantee payment of any judgment secured against said licensee for his negligence, default or breach of conduct in the performance of his duties authorized by the said license but the Surety's total liability shall not exceed the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.)
