

ORDINANCE NO. 2496

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY COURT OF LINN COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPOINTMENT OF THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER AS THE CITY HEALTH OFFICER; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2279; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Linn County Court, pursuant to Section 99-201 O.C.L.A., amended by O.L. '53, Ch. 189, for the purpose of providing and allowing the County Health Officer to serve as Health Officer of the City of Albany to the extent required by the above mentioned section of O.C.L.A.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 2279, Ordinances of the City of Albany is hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3: Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
