

ORDINANCE NO. 2499

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, THE 1952 EDITION OF THE PACIFIC COAST BUILDING OFFICIALS CONFERENCE, UNIFORM BUILDING CODE INCLUDING VOLUMES 1 AND 2 AND THE LEGISLATIVE SECTIONS AND APPENDIX ATTACHED THERETO, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2161, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Albany does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Uniform Building Code, 1952 Edition, prepared and adopted by the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, of 124 West Fourth Street, Los Angeles, California, contained in Volumes 1 and 2 and including the legislative sections and appendix attached thereto and all subsequent amendments thereto be, and the same is hereby adopted, accepted, passed and approved as the building code in and for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 2161 passed by the council on February 10, 1950 and approved by the Mayor February 10, 1950, and Ordinance No. 641 passed by the council on May 14, 1913 and approved by the Mayor May 16, 1913, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall become immediately operative, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage by the council and its approval by the Mayor.
