WHEREAS, the Council on the 18th day of March, 1953, by Resolution No. 260, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the above named streets in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, on the 24 th day of June, 1953, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of HILL STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF 99E TO THE SOUTH LINE OF 7TH AVENUE, by improvement in the following manner:

Preparing base and hard surfacing and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable costs thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's offlce of sald city, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 265" and adopted the 244 h day of June, 1953.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 24th day of June, 1953, by Resolution No. 266, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that It deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the above named streets in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of August, 1953, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution recuiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of 18 TH aVENUE FROM THE EAST LINE OF HILL STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF MAIN STREET BY INPROVEMENT IN the following manner:

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable costs thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filled in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 268" and adopted the 26th day of August, 1953.

WrEREAS, the City Engineer of the said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 268, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by sald Resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 268 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of sald city on the 26 th day of August, 1953.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 18th day of March, 1953, on the 24 th day of June, 1953, on the 26th day of August, 1953, by Resolution Nos. 260, 266, and 269, duly adopted by sald Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the above named streets in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution Nos. 260, 266, and 269, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by sald Council to glve notice of said proposed improvement of said streets in the manner provided in sald Resolution Nos. 260, 266, and 269.

WIBREAS, no remonstrances were filed, after notice was given as provided by lav, and the Councll of sald City of Albany, on the 44 , day of August, 1953, the 10 th day of July, 1953 , the 23rd day of September, 1953 , duly passed Ordinance Nos. 2473, 2491, 2500 catablishing the time and manner of making sald improvements.

WHEREAS, the sald Improvements aroresaid, have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter of the Clty of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLONS:
Section 1. That the cost of making said improvement of said streots
in the manner heretofore determined by the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, in and by Resolutions Nos. 260,266 and 269 and in Ordinance Nos. 2473, 2491, 2500 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald portion of said street and particularly benefited thereby is hereby declared to be the sum of $\$ 111,182.41$.

Section 2. The proportionate share of sald costs of said improvement of said streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to sald part of sald street improved and particularly benefited thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
