ORDINANCE NO. 2503

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2501 BY SEGREGATING THE CERTAIN LIEN THEREIN CREATED AND CORRECTING AN ASSESSMENT LIEN THEREIN CREATED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2501 be and the same is hereby amended to segregate the said lien therein created against Earl Kenagy for the west 61.6 feet of Lot 9, Block 16, Daly and Kelly Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres by assessing the same as follows: Earl Kenagy, all of Lot 9, except the easterly twenty feet thereof, of Block 16, Daly and Kelly Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, \$254.88; to Robert F. Daly and wife, the easterly twenty feet of Lot 9, Block 16, Daly and Kelly Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, \$82.74.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 2501 be amended at the point wherein Lot 1, Block 125, Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany is assessed to F. D. Ginther in the sum of \$419.30 be amended to assess the said Lot 1, Block 125, Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany to Charles Childs in the sum of \$419.30; and that where Lot 4, Block 122, Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany has been assessed to Charles Childs in the sum of \$472.86, be amended to assess the said Lot 4, Block 122, Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany to F. D. Ginther in the sum of \$472.86.

Section 3: Wherein it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany that the above Ordinance become immediately effective upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor in that the bonds for the said assessments described in Ordinance No. 2501 must be sold at the earliest possible date to reduce the interest rates thereon and the overall costs to the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
