

ORDINANCE NO. 2518

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2141, SECTION 13 THEREOF PERTAINING TO THE HAULING AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE: AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF FEES FOR USE OF THE CITY DUMP.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 13 of Ordinance No. 2141 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, save and excepting the contractor as herein set forth, to deposit any garbage or rubbish at said city dump except as in this ordinance provided.

Residents and commercial establishments of the City of Albany shall have the right to deposit garbage or rubbish upon payment of a reasonable fee to the contractor, said fee schedule to be first approved by the Council.

The contractor shall provide an employee at the city dump during the hours that are designated by the Council.

As part of the consideration of the contract, the contractor shall keep the city dump in a good and orderly condition throughout the term of the contract and shall comply with all State, County and Federal regulations respecting the same at the contractor's own expense.

The Council shall reserve the right to cancel the contract, after notice and hearing, of any violation or breach of the contract of this ordinance.

The contractor shall promptly and properly collect garbage and rubbish in the City of Albany and shall charge rates not in excess of those provided in this ordinance."
