ORDINANCE NO. 2529

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF IMPROVEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE SANTIAM HIGHWAY SO MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN RESOLUTION NO. 282, PROVIDING HOW THE COST THE IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE PAID, DIRECTING THAT THE IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE MADE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE CITY ENGINEER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Santiam Highway from a point 150 feet west of the west line of Denver Street South to a point 300 feet west of the west line Denver Street South being the uncompleted portion of the 1952 improvement of the Santiam Highway from Denver Street to Pine Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

Preparation of base Leveling Course, and Placing suitable asphalt hard surface pavement

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and the plans and specifications and estimates for the improvement of the said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the second day of June, 1954.

Section 2. The cost of making said improvements shall be paid out of the assessments hereinafter to be made ascertained and declared by the council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of the said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 3. That by reason of the type and amount of the said improvement the council specifically finds that it would be unreasonable to advertise the same for bids and directs that the said improvement to be made by the City of Albany under the supervision of the City Engineer, according to the plans and specifications heretofore mentioned.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
