ORDINANCE NO. 2533

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1681, AS AMENDED, Sec. 6, TO PROVIDE FOR ONE HOUR PARKING LIMIT IN PORTIONS OF THE METER ZONE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 1681, Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, as the same has been amended, Section 6 thereof, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6: It shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle registered in his name or operated or controlled by him to be upon any street within a parking meter zone in any space adjacent to which a parking meter is installed, for more than the consecutive minutes indicated upon the said adjacent parking meter, or any time that such meter is showing a signal indicating that such space is illegally in use between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock P.M. of any day, Sundays and legal holidays excepted.

"Both sides of First Avenue and Second Avenue between Lyon Street and Ferry Street and both sides of Ellsworth Street, Broadalbin Street and Ferry Street between First Avenue and Second Avenue are designated as 60 minute zones. The balance of the meter zone, as described in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be a 120 minute zone.

"The Council may designate more limited spaces in said zone or zones and may further provide for the marking prescribed by Section 5 of this Ordinance in such a manner to provide the maximum use of said space, all in accord with accept practices of traffic engineering."

Section 2: This ordinance, upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, shall become effective on the 15th day of October, 1954, at the hour of 1:00 o'clock, A.M.
