ORDINANCE NO. 2547

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE "KING OFFICE EQUIPMENT COMPANY" FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ELECTRIC ADDING MACHINE FROM KING OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for an electric adding machine for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

- WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the King Office Equipment Company, of Albany, Oregon for the purchase of one Sundstrand Electric Adding Machine-Model 10140P in the sum of \$375.00 less trade in allowance on one Underwood Sundstrand Adding Machine in the sum of \$177.50, making a balance on the contract of \$197.50 and, by this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
