Davidson Street from the South line of 8 th Avenue to connect with the pavement on Highway 20 by the following:

Addition of base rock where it is low, and
Leveling course, and
Placing thereon a sultable asphaltic hard surface pavement.
and for the estimates of the work to be done on sald portions of sald street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of sald City, sald Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 277 ", and adopted the 12 th day of Nay, 1954.

WHEREAS, the Clity Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to sald Resolution No. 277, made plans, speciflcations and estimates as directed by sald Resolution for the improvement of said streets In the manner specified in said Resolution. No. 277, and flied sald plans, speciflcations and estimates in the Recorder's office of the sald City on the 12 th day of May, 1954.

Whereas, the city Engineer of the city of Albany, pursuant to sald Resolution No, 232, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of sald streets in the manner specifled in sald Resolution No. 282, and flled sald plans, spectifications and estimates in the Recorder's Cffice of said City on the 2nd day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 9 th day of June, 1954, the councll of the city of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to make plans, specifications for the improvement of:

Sherman Street from 14 th Avenue to Queen Avenue by:
Grade and Gravel
Curb and Gutter
Drainage
and for the estimates of the work to be done on sald portion of sald street and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's orfice of said city sald Resolution beling endorsed Resolution No. 283, and adopted the 9th day of June, 1954.
filed sald plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of sald City on the 9 th day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, in and by sald Resolutions Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 283, adopted as aforesald by the Council the Recorder of sald Clity was duly ordered and directed by said councli to glve notice of sald proposed improvement of sald streets In the manner provided in said Resolution Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 283.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were flled after notice was given as provided by law, and the councli of said City of Albany on the 23rd day of June, 1954, and on the first day of July, 1954, duly passed ordinances Nos. 2525, 2528, and 2529, establishing the time and manner of making said improvements.

WHEREAS, the said improvements aforesald have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Cregon, and with the Charter with the City of Albany, Oregon.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAIY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of making saldstreets in the manner heretofore determined by the Councll of the City of Albany, Oregon in and by Resolutions Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 283, and In Ordinances Nos. 2525, 2528, and 2529, to be pald by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald portion of said street, and particularly benefitted thereby does hereby declare to be the sum of $\$ 22,231.34$ of which the City of Albany shall pay the sum of $\$ 2,092.39$ for intersectlons and drainage and the balance of $\$ 20,138.45$ shall be paid by the real owners of the property adjacent to sald streets and parilcularly beneflited thereby.

Section 2: The proportionate share of said costs of sald improvement of sald streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street improved and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each or such lots or parts thereof as follows:
