AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. 276, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 12TH DAY OF MAY, 1954, RESOLUTION NO. 277, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 12TH DAY OF MAY, 1954, RESOLUTION NO. 279, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 12TH DAY OF MAY, 1954, AND RESOLUTION NO. 282, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 9TH DAY OF JUNE, 1954, RESOLUTION NO. 283, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 9TH DAY OF JUNE, 1954, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS:

Burkhart Street from the Southerly Edge of the Pavement on 99E, Southerly to connect with the pavement on Highway 20.

Davidson Street from the South line of 3th Avenue to connect with the pavement on Highway 20.

12th Avenue from Maple Street to Elm Street.

14th Avenue from the East line of Walnut Street to the West line of Maple Street.

Santiam Highway from a point 150 feet West of the West line of Denver Street South, to a point 300 feet West of the West line of Denver Street South, being the uncompleted portion of the 1952 improvement of Santiam Highway from Denver Street to Pine Street.

Sherman Street from 14th Avenue to Queen Avenue.

to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of each cost of each improvement of said street or streets that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part to said street improved; to direct the Recorder of the said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1954, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the following streets; improvement in the following manner:

Burkhart Street from the Southerly Edge of the Pavement on 99E, Southerly to connect with the pavement on Highway 20 by the following:

Shape up present gravel base by adding leveling course, and

Placing thereon a suitable asphalt hard surface pavement, and sidewalks where none exist.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portions of said street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the R<sub>e</sub>corder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 276", and adopted the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 276, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 276, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1954, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the following streets; improvement in the following manner:

Davidson Street from the South line of 8th Avenue to connect with the pavement on Highway 20 by the following:

Addition of base rock where it is low, and

Leveling course, and

Placing thereon a suitable asphaltic hard surface pavement.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portions of said street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 277", and adopted the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 277, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution. No. 277, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of the said City on the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1954, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the following streets; improvement in the following

12th Avenue from Maple Street to Elm Street by the following:

1. Shape up level base with leveling course, and,

2. Place a suitable asphaltic hard surface.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portions of said street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 279", and adopted the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 279, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 279, and filed said plans, specifications, and estimates in the Recorder's Office of the said City on the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1954, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the following streets; improvement in the following manner:

14th Avenue from the East line of Walnut Street to the West line of Maple Street by the following:

1. Preparation of base, and,

2. Suitable hard surface.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portions of said street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 280", and adopted the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 280, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 280 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of said City on the 12th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of June, 1954, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of:

Santiam Hiway from a point 150' West of the West line of Denver Street South, to a point 300' West of the West line of Denver Street South, being the uncompleted portion of the 1952 improvement of Santiam Highway from Denver Street to Pine Street, by the following:

1. Preparation of Base,

2. Leveling course, and

3. Placing thereon a suitable asphaltic hard surface pavement.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City said Resolution being endorsed Resolution No. 282, and adopted the 9th day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 232, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 282, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of said City on the 2nd day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of June, 1954, the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of:

Sherman Street from 14th Avenue to Queen Avenue by:

Grade and Gravel Curb and Gutter Drainage

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City said Resolution being endorsed Resolution No. 283, and adopted the 9th day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuance to said Resolution No 283, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 283, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of said City on the 9th day of June, 1954.

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolutions Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 283, adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said streets in the manner provided in said Resolution Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 283.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were filed after notice was given as provided by law, and the council of said City of Albany on the 23rd day of June, 1954, and on the first day of July, 1954, duly passed ordinances Nos. 2525, 2528, and 2529, establishing the time and manner of making said improvements.

WHEREAS, the said improvements aforesaid have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon, and with the Charter with the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of making said streets in the manner heretofore deter-mined by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon in and by Resolutions Nos. 276, 277, 279, 280, 282, and 263, and in Ordinances Nos. 2525, 2528, and 2529, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street, and parti-cularly benefitted thereby does hereby declare to be the sum of \$22,231,34 of which the City of Albany shall pay the sum of \$2,092,39 for intersections and drainage and the balance of \$20,138.45 shall be paid by the real owners of the property adjacent to said streets and particularly benefitted thereby. said streets and particularly benefitted thereby.

The proportionate share of said costs of said improvement of said Section 2: streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street improved and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
