ORDINANCE NO. 2562

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FURNACE OIL FROM THE GENERAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for the purchase of furnace oil for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time set forth in the said notice, and

WHEREAS, the Council determined the bid of the GENERAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION to be the most favorable bid.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the GENERAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF FURNACE OIL for the year commencing January 1, 1955 and ending December 31, 1955, at the posted price applicable to commercial consummer accounts but not to exceed .1209 per gallon, and

By this Ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

In as much as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
