## ORDINANCE NO. 2563

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FORD PICKUP WITH J. E. DERRY IN A SUM NOT EXCEEDING \$300.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this Ordinance, deem it impractible to obtain bids for a Ford Pickup.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Ford Pickup, Motor No. 799C1558161 not to exceed the sum of \$300.00 for the Sewer Disposal Plant, with J. E. Derry, Old Corvallis Road.

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

In as much as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
