## ORDINANCE NO. 2577

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WILLAMETTE CONCRETE PIPE & PRODUCTS COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF CONCRETE PIPE FROM THE WILLAMETTE CONCRETE PIPE AND PRODUCTS COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for concrete pipe for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Willamette Concrete Pipe and Products Company, 325 Queen Avenue, Albany, Oregon for the purchase of approximately 2590 feet of 10" T&G Concrete culvert pipe at the price of 55 cents per foot and approximately 2660 feet of 12" T&G Concrete Culvert pipe at the price of 64 cents per foot, according to the plans and specifications now on file with the City Engineer.

Section 2: By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Section 3: Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immeidate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
