AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF IMPROVEMENT OF QUEEN AVENUE FROM THE EAST LINE OF BROADWAY STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF HIGHWAY 99-E, ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON; PROVIDING HOW THE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE PAID, AUTHORIZING THE IMPROVEMENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Queen Avenue, from the east line of Broadway Street to the west line of Highway 99-E, Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be improved in the following manner, to-wit: By grading, drainage, base and suitable surfacing.

Said improvements shall be made in conjunction with the State Highway Commission under the proposed terms wherein the State of Oregon acting through the State Highway Commission has submitted plans, specifications and estimates filed with the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, by the City Engineer and the State Highway Commission, pursuant to Resolution No. 298 and in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany.

The cost of making said improvements will be chargeable 75% to the State of Oregon acting through the State Highway Commission, and 25% to the City of Albany and adjacent property owners in the proportion as set forth in Resolution No. 313, dated the 13th day of April, 1955; that proportion chargeable to lots and part of lots adjacent to said street so improved shall be paid out of funds to be collected and arising upon and out of assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on said lots and part of lots adjacent to said portion of the said street so to be improved, as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, and as provided by the Charter of the City of Albany.

Section 2: That portion of the cost of improving the said street above described and designated as the cost of the City of Albany in Resolution No. 313, dated the 13th day of April, 1955, shall be paid for at the general expense of the City of Albany.

Section 3: The Mayor and the City Manager are authorized to enter into a contract with the State of Oregon acting through the State Highway Commission for the improvement of the above described street in accordance with the plans and specifications and estimated filed with the Recorder of the City of Albany by the City Engineer

and the State Highway Commission pursuant to Resolution No. 298 and in accordance with Resolution No. 315.

Section 4: The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice that the State Highway Commission will receive bids for the above described improvements by publishing such notice in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany three times not less than ten days prior to the date of receiving of the bids by the State Highway Commission, setting forth fully the time and manner of doing said work of improving said street all in accordance with the charter of the City of Albany.

Section 5: Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
