ORDINANCE NO 2583

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE NELSON EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE HOSE FROM THE NELSON EQUIPMENT COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for fire hose for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS'FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Nelson Equipment Company, 5251 S. E. McLoughlin Blvd, Portland, Oregon, for the purchase of 400 feet of 3½ inch treated double jacket cotton rubber lined fire hose with couplings, coupled in 50 foot lengths at the price of \$2.65 per foot plus 20 cents per foot for dacron filler making a total purchase price in the amount of \$1,140.00.

Section 2. By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
