ORDINANCE NO. 2586

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OVERHEAD DOOR COMPANY OF SALEM, OREGON FOR THE PURCHASE OF ELECTRIC DOOR CONTROLS FROM THE OVERHEAD DOOR COMPANY OF SALEM, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for electric door controls for two doors in the fire hall, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Overhead Door Company of Salem, Oregon, 2005 Oxford Street, Salem, Oregon for the purchase of two-Model B. electric door controls, 1 push button station, installed on doors for a total purchase price of \$450.00.

Section 2. By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
