ORDINANCE NO. 2603

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE CONTRACT WITH STEVENS AND THOMPSON CONSULTING ENGINEERS OF PORTLAND, OREGON FOR THE PREPARATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWER MAINS AND LATERALS WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a request for construction of certain sanitary sewer mains and laterals in Hazelwood Addition has been made, and

WHEREAS, the need for construction of certain sewers in other sections of the City seems apparent, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer is unable to do such work due to the pressing of other matters.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Albany enter into a contract with the Engineering Firm of Stevens and Thompson, Portland, Oregon, for the preparation of plans and specifications for said sanitary sewer mains and laterals to serve the area known as Hazelwood Addition within the City of Albany, Oregon under such terms as might be mutually satisfactory between the contracting parties, and authorize payment of such reasonable fee as agreed upon in the contract.

That the Mayor and City Manager be authorized to execute such contract and the Recorder to attest such signature to bind the City of Albany for payment therefore.

Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
