## ORDI NANCE NO. 2609

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. 281, ADOFTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 12TH DAY OF NAY, 1954, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLONING STREET:

Ninth Avenue from Lafayette Street to Hill Street
to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of each cost of each Improvement of said street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to sald part to sald street Improved; to direct the Recorder of the said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.


#### Abstract

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1954, the Councll of the Clty of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the following street in the following manner:


Ninth Avenue from Lafayette Street to HIll Street

Curb \& Gutter<br>Grade \& Gravel<br>Drainage<br>Sultable Hard Surfacing

and for the estimates of the work to be done on sald portions of sald street, and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cast be filed in the Recorder's offlce of said City, sald Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 281", and adopted the 12 th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, the City Englneer of the CIty of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 28l, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by sald Resolution far the improvement of said streets in the manner specifled In sald Resolution No. 281, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates In the Recorder's orfice of sald City on the 12 th day of May, 1954.

WHEREAS, in and by sald Resolution No. 281, adopted on the 12 th day of May, 1954 by the Council, the Recorder of sald City was duly ordered and directed by sald council to give notice of sald proposed improvement of sald street in the manner provided in sald Resolution No. 281.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were filed after notice was given as provided by law, and the council of sald City of Albany on the 26 th day of Nay, 1955 , duly passed Ordinance No. 2580, establishing the time and manner of making sald improvenents.

WHEREAS, the sald improvement aforesald heve been duly made in accordance with the laws of the state of Oregon, and with the Charter with the city of Albany, Oregon.
THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO CRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1: That the cost of making said street in the manner heretofore deterinlned by the Councll of the Clty of Albany in and by Resolution No. 291, and In Ordinance No. 2580, to be pald by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald portion of street, and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby declared to be the sum of $\$ 9,935.96$ of which the Clty of Albany shall pay the sum of $\$ 1,206,57$ for intersectlons and drainage and the balance of $\$ 8,729.39$ shall be pald by the real owners of the property adjacent to said street and particularly beneflited thereby.

Section 2: The proportionate share of sald costs of sald improvement of sald street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of sald street improved and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed imaediately after the separate descriptlons of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
