AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. 300, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 9TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 309, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 310, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 312, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 312, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 1955, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS:

TUDOR WAY from 21st Avenue to 22nd Avenue

TWENTY-SECOND AVENUE from Hill to East line of Hollywood Acres Acres Addition

NINTH AVENUE from Clay to Ermine Street

to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such cost of such improvement of said street or streets that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of February, 1955, and on the 23rd day of March, 1955, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of the following streets; by improvement in the following manner:

TUDOR WAY from 21st Avenue to 22nd Avenue, by grade and gravel, curb and gutters, asphalt concrete, drainage.

TWENTY-SECOND AVENUE from Hill to East line of Hollywood Acres Addition, by grade and gravel, curb and gutters, drainage, and suitable hard surfacing.

NINTH AVENUE from Clay Street to Ermine Street, by grade and gravel, curb and gutters, drainage, and suitable hard surfacing.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable costs thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 300", "Resolution No. 310", and "Resolution No. 309", and adopted the 9th day of February, 1955, and the 23rd day of March, 1955.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No's 300, 309, and 310, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolutions for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No's 300, 309, and 310, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of said City on the 23rd day of March, 1955.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 23rd day of March, 1955, by Resolution No. 312, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the above named streets in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were filed, after notice was given as provided by law, and the Council of said City of Albany, on the 26th day of May, 1955, duly passed Ordinance No. 2580 establishing the time and manner of making said improvements.

WHEREAS, the said improvements aforesaid, have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of making said improvement of said streets in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, in and by Resolutions No's 300, 309, 310, and 312 and in Ordinance No. 2580 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby declared to be in the sum of \$12,503.84.

Section 2: The proportionate share of said costs of said improvement of said streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said streets assessed upon each lot of part thereof adjacent to said part of said street improved and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate des-criptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
