## ORDINANCE NO. 2616

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CLASSES OF LOADING ZONES, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL TO DESIGNATE THE SAME BY RESOLUTION, PROVIDING FOR AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR CERTAIN TYPES AND REPEALING SECTION 16 OR ORDINANCE NO. 1681 AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: There is hereby established the following classes of loading zones in the City of Albany:

## a. General loading zones:

These zones shall be for the general use of those persons actually receiving or delivering goods, wares and merchandise to the area near the loading zone. They shall not be considered the individual parking place for any commercial vehicle but are for the use of the general public in loading or unloading.

## b. Specific loading zones:

These zones shall be for the use of a particular business or merchant and shall only be issued when there is no other space available for loading or unloading. The council shall not be obligated to establish specific loading zones.

If specific loading zones are established in the meter zone as defined by Ordinance No. 1681, the business or merchant to whom the zone is issued shall pay to the City an annual license fee in the sum of \$60.00 or proration thereof for any part of a year. The license fee shall become payable upon the creation of the zone and upon the first day of January thereafter while the zone remains in effect.

Section 2: The Council shall designate the zones and shall by resolution regulate the time the loading zone shall be in effect. If the loading zone is in the meter zone, the balance of the day when not in use as a loading zone, the same shall be a regular meter zone and governed by the ordinances relating thereto.

Section 3: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1681 and all ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

Section 4: Upon establishment of loading zones by resolution, the City Manager shall have the same appropriately market.

Section 5: Any person or persons found guilty of the violation of the providions of this ordinance in the Municipal Court of Albany, shall be punished by a fine of not less than ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) nor more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than ten days.
