ORDINANCE NO. 2624

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF LATERAL SEWERS IN HAZELWOOD ADDITION; PROVIDING FOR THE COSTS OF THE IMPROVEMENT; DIRECTING THE RECORDER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS; AND DE-CLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Recitals:

- 1. The Council determined to make certain improvements in Resolution No. 348.
- Notices were posted as required by Section 212 of the Charter and no remonstrances have been filed.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The following improvements shall be made as herein provided:

LATERAL SEWERS IN HAZELWOOD ADDITION

The improvements are to be made in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Recorder and referred to in Resolution No. 348.

Section 2: The costs of the lateral sewer improvements shall be paid from special assessments of the property particularly benefitted as provided in Section 215 of the Charter.

Section 3: The Recorder is directed to advertise for bids upon the improvements as required by Section 216 of the Charter. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a bond as security for full performance of the contract. All bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or its equivalent equal to 5% of the total bid.

Section 4: The improvement shall be completed not later than December 31, 1956. Unless the above time is extended by the Council, the City shall be deemed to suffer liquidated damages of \$25.00 per day thereafter.

Section 5: Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
