AN ONDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. 327, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 22ND DAY OF JUNE, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 324, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 82H DAY OF JUNE, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 322, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 82H DAY OF JUNE, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 323, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 325, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 325, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 25TH DAY OF JUNE, 1955, RESOLUTION NO. 325, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 3TH DAY OF JUNE, 1955, AND RESOLUTION NO. 329, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 13TH DAY OF JULY, 1955, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLOWING STREET AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SEWER IMPROVEMENTS:

STREET: TUDOR WAY from 14th Avenue to Queen Avenue

SEWERS: LATERAL 1. Beginning at:

THIRTEENTH AVENUE midway between Madison Street and Hill Street running thence South parallel to Madison and Hill Streets to Queen Avenue.

LATERAL 2. Beginning at:

FOURTEENTH AVENUE midway between Hill Street and Tudor Way running thence South parallel to Hill Street and Tudor Way to Queen Avenue.

LATERAL 3. Beginning at:

FOURTEENTH AVENUE midway between Hill Street and Tudor Way and Main Street and running thence South parallel to Tudor Way and Main Street to Queen Avenue.

to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such cost of such improvement of said street, streets, or sanitary sewers that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street improved or sewer installed; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of June, 1955, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications for the improvement of the following street; by improvement in the following manner:

TUDOR WAY from the South line of 14th Avenue to the North line of Queen Avenue, by grade and gravel, curb and gutters, asphaltic concrete and drainage.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable costs thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution N_0 . 327".

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of May, 1955, and on the 8th day of June, 1955, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted Resolutions requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans, specifications, and estimates for the improvement by the installation of the following sanitary sewer laterals.

SEWERS: LATERAL 1. Beginning at:

THIRTEENTH AVENUE midway between Madison Street and Hill Street running South parailel to Madison and Hill Streets to Queen Avenue.

LATERAL 2. Beginning at:

FOURTEENTH AVENUE midway between Hill Street and Tudor Way running thence South parallel to Hill Street and Tudor Way to Oueen Avenue.

LATERAL 3. Beginning at:

FOURTEENTH AVENUE midway between Hill Street and Tudor Way and Main Street and running thence South parallel to Tudor Way and Main Street to Queen Avenue.

and for the estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates, and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said Resolutions being endorsed Resolution No. 322 and Resolution No. 324, respectively.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No's 327, 322, and 324, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said streets and sewers in the manner specified in said Resolution No's 327, 322, and 324 and filed in the Recorder's Office of said City on the 8th day of June, 1955, and on the 13th day of July, 1955.

ORDINANCE NO. 2625, CONT'D.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 13th day of July, 1955, by Resolution No. 329, and on May 25, 1955, by Resolution No. 323, and on June 8, 1955, by Resolution No. 325 all of said Resolutions being duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to make the improvements in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were filed, after notice was given as provided by law, and the Council of the City of Albany on the 13th day of July, 1955 and on the 27th day of July, 1955 duly passed Ordinances No's 2591 and 2592, establishing a time and manner of making said improvements.

WHEREAS, the said improvements aforesaid, have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of making said improvement of said streets and sewers in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, and by Resolutions No's 323, 325, and 329, and in Ordinances No's 2591 and 2592 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and sewers and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby declared to be in the sum of \$22,159.52.

Section 2: The proportionate share of said costs of said improvement of said streets and sewers assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street or sewers improved and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
