Real Alternation and the second second second

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2338, ORDINANCE NO. 2501, AND ORDINANCE NO. 2509, BY SEGREGATING THE LIEN OF LUTHER B. SLAUGHTER THEREIN ESTABLISHED.

WHEREAS, Luther B. Slaughter was assessed for certain street and sewer improvements in Ordinance No. 2338, 2501, and 2609 under the following described property:

Lots 15 and 16, Block 3, Hollywood Acres Addition

WHEREAS, said assessments were in the total sum of 1,607.76, and payment was made on March 2, 1956 in the amount of 1,042.74, and on November 14, 1952 payments in the total amount of 12.20, and payments were made on May 5, 1953, in the total amount of 12.20, leaving a balance due on the principal in the amount of 540.62 plus interest at the rate of 6% from March 2, 1956, and

WHEREAS, said property owner is desirous of having the lien of said assessment segregated.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO GRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2338, 2501, and 2609 be amended to segregate the liens therein created on the above described property owned by Luther B. Slaughter at the time of the assessment and how owned by John Boock in the following manner:

John Boock, Lots 15 and 16, except the north 75 feet of each lot, Block 3, Hollywood Acres Addition.

Section 2: That the City Recorder is hereby directed to make the necessary entries in the lien docket in the City of Albany to segregate said lien as above set forth.

Section 3: That no lien be assessed to the north 75 feet of Lots 15 and 16, Block 3, Hollywood Acres Addition as a result of this segregation.

Section 4: That interest be charged on said lien as described in Section 1, hereof at the rate of 6% per annum beginning March 2, 1956, until paid.
