AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2626.

## Recitals:

- 1. Dorothea Hackelman Houston was assessed the sum of \$35.00 for the abatement as a nuisance, of grass from the property in accordance with the provisions with Ordinance No. 1321.
- The Council of the City of Albany has determined said assessment to be in an amount which is excessive according to the results of the work done.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the assessment on property owned by Dorothea Hackelman Houston in the amount of \$35.00 as described in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2626, be reduced to the total sum of \$20.00.

Section 2: The Recorder is hereby instructed to enter the above reduced assessment and to strike out the old assessment levied by Ordinance No. 2626 on the lien docket of the City and proceed with the collection thereof in the same manner as street assessments.

Section 3: That the balance of \$15.00 shall be paid out of the general fund of the City of Albany.
