Section 1: That the cost of making said improvements of sald streets heretofore determined by the Council of the City of Albany, in and by Resolutions No. 312 and 313, and in Ordinance No. 2578, and 2580 to be pald by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald portion of said streets and particularly benefitted
 to the United States of America Bureau of Mines property, and the balance of $\$ 15,249.45$ shall be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to sald street and particularly benefitted thereby.
