ORDINANCE CO. 2676

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR AN EMPLOYE POSITION CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY STUDY WITH THE STATE OF OREGON, CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this ordinance, deem it impractible to obtain bids for an employe classification and salary study.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for an employe position classification and salary study for the City of Albany with the Civil Service Commission of the State of Oregon for a sum not to exceed \$400.00.

Section 3: In as much as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
