## ORDINANCE NO. 2677

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LINN COUNTY, OREGON, AND THE STATE OF OREGON HIGHWAY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE BRYANT'S PARK BRIDGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Highway Commission, and Linn County, Oregon, for the purpose of securing the replacement of the wood covered bridge situated at the crossing of the Calapooia River near W. 3rd Ave., commonly known as the Bryant's Park Bridge, with a reinforced concrete structure.

<u>Section 2:</u> The city shall contribute a sum of money, for the replacement of said bridge, not to exceed \$32,000.00.

<u>Section 3:</u> In as much as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
