ORDINANCE NO. 2678

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE PACIFIC POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY TO PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF ELECTRIC LIGHTING UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Pacific Power and Light Company, a corporation, to provide for the furnishing of electric lighting service for lighting U. S. Pacific Highway 99E from Waverly Drive to Queen Avenue and U. W. Highway 20 (Ellsworth and Lyon Streets) from Third Avenue to U. S. Pacific Highway 99E, for a period of 10 (Ten) years from and after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 2: The annual cost for such street and highway lighting shall not exceed \$8,859.00 unless the Council, by resolution, provides for additions thereto.

Section 3: It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Albany that the lighting service provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance is necessary to enable said City to provide proper protection for itself and the inhabitants thereof, and is essential to the security and welfare of said City and its inhabitants.
